

## NCTU Covenant for Camp Activities

As the person in charge of \_\_\_\_\_ camp, I, \_\_\_\_\_, hereby agree to exhort a quiet campus environment during activities, cultivate positive personal habits, and fully comply with relevant university regulations. If violations of the regulations listed below are verified, the camp participants and I are willing to accept disciplinary measures by the university without any complaints or objections.

- I. The design of camp activities must conform to relevant national laws and regulations and ethical principles and constraints.
- II. Camp participants shall fully comply with the relevant dorm regulations. If male and female students have to share dorm areas, the principles of separate use shall be strictly enforced. Bathroom usage times for male and female students shall be announced beforehand to facilitate the use by other students.
- III. Students shall not lodge in campus areas other than the dormitories. It is also strictly forbidden to cook or sleep in all areas of the activity center and all classrooms.
- IV. Camp participants shall abide by the usage regulations for all campus areas and buildings and shall not turn off the water, electricity, or gas supply in public areas at will. They are also not allowed to turn off the lighting in public areas during activity times, place props in hallways, or use power supplies without permission. All actions that affect the public safety of other students are strictly forbidden. For instance, the lighting in public entrance and exit areas shall not be turned off at will and escape routes and facilities shall not be blocked (e.g., students shall not turn off the lighting of the Assembly Building parking lot or fool around and scare other students)
- V. If campfire activities are organized, a camp participant must be put in charge of the activity (Name:\_\_\_\_\_, Mobile:\_\_\_\_\_). Camp organizers shall fill out the Application Form for the Reservation of Public Areas of NCTU and complete the reservation procedures in accordance with the relevant regulations of the Division of General Affairs. They shall also specify the name of the supervising instructor of the respective department for the campfire activity on the reservation form (Name:\_\_\_\_\_ Mobile:\_\_\_\_\_). The Division of General Affairs shall confirm this information with the department instructor by phone. The term campfire refers to wood pile or brazier-type campfires. Performances involving fireballs, fire staffs, or torches are strictly forbidden to avoid safety hazards on campus.

- VI. If camp organizers wish to apply for barbecue activities on campus, they shall proceed to the Division of General Affairs and fill out the "Application Form for the Reservation of NCTU Barbecue Areas" and complete the reservation procedures for the barbecue areas in the western part of the campus. It is strictly forbidden to organize barbecue activities in other campus areas without obtaining prior permission from the university.
- VII. It is prohibited to move facilities and equipment in activity areas or classrooms at will. The cleanliness of the environment must be maintained and areas must be restored to their original condition after use in a prompt fashion.
- VIII. It is prohibited to yell, shout, or generate excessive noise during camp activities to avoid disturbing others in nearby campus buildings. All daily activities must be concluded by 10:30 pm.
- IX. If it is necessary to ride scooters on campus, organizers shall proceed to the campus police office to complete the required procedures. Camp participants shall abide by the relevant government regulations and refrain from speeding and exceeding load limits. Riders are required to wear safety helmets.
- X. It is forbidden to put up promotional posters at will without obtaining prior permission from management units of campus buildings.
- XI. When organizing off-campus activities, participants are required to strictly abide by etiquette rules to safeguard the reputation of the university. This includes neat appearance and dress and quiet and orderly behavior to avoid disturbing others.
- XII. It is strictly forbidden to falsely assume the identity of student clubs (student associations) to make reservations for dorms, classrooms, and campus areas on behalf of non-university members.
- XIII. The number of participants staying in dorms shall be reported in an accurate fashion. It is not allowed to make false reports or occupy dorm space at will. The actual number of occupied dorm beds shall not fall short of 70% of the originally requested number.
- XIV. Important reminders for camp activities
  - (a) Activities that are harmful to the health of participants such as eating contests, chili-eating competitions, or fast-eating contests are strictly forbidden.
  - (b) Indoor activities involving fire and the release of high-pressure gases are strictly forbidden (such as fire dancing or sparklers).
  - (c) Fireworks, balloons, streamers, and alcohol are also forbidden.
- XV. If camp activities violate any of the abovementioned regulations and thereby affect the public safety and order on campus or cause harm or loss to others, the rights of the organizers shall be suspended upon the receipt of reports from other units and incidents shall be handled in accordance with university regulations

based on the seriousness of the offense.
